Background

Hillstown Brewery was created following the success of Hillstown Farmshop and Geterbrewed's collaboration in creating Beer Fed Beef.

The initial brewery which is based on a family farm near Randalstown in county Antrim, was for agricultural use feeding cattle until the owners decided to expand into the exciting craft beer sector.

The brewery produces a unique range of craft beers. All the brewing operations are carried out on the farm and can be seen by visitors.

A new and experienced master brewer, Alistair Thompson has been appointed. An eye-catching re-branding of the beers has also just been completed.

The innovative brewery teamed up with a coffee business to launch Pamoja, an original beer in cans featuring a new identity. It has since added a second canned beer using its established Henrietta the Hen, a Californian style pale ale.

In April, the team at Hillstown Brewery announced that they will be creating Northern Ireland's first museum of craft brewing. They have won backing from the international Économusée network to create a 'working museum' that showcases artisans at work.

Product Range

The Goats Butt (Wheat Beer): Multiple award winning Northern Irish wheat beer. Mouth watering aromas of banana, citrus & ripe summer fruit. Spicy note from the rye and a citrusy taste from the hops

Massey Red Ale: A pleasant malt based ale with a subtle sweetness, caramel and chocolate flavours

The Horny Bull Stout: A Strong full bodied stout with liquorice, chocolate and coffee notes, exceptional depth with roasted flavours, the fruity hops really make it special and unlike any other stout

The Spitting Llama: Ireland's Champion Belgian Ale, a strong golden ale which is aromatic combined with complex spices and a mild fruit presence. A local favourite already.

Pamoja: A black IPA (ABC 5.6%) in 330ml cans aimed primarily at the off-trade in Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland. Perfectly balanced with an initial upfront hit of fruity hops, underpinned by a delicious malt presence and, then the exciting part – coffee.
